

Annexe A to Standing Orders for Edingale Parish Council

Capital Proceeds-funded works and services

1. Where the Council is funding work to be carried out, whether it arranges the work itself or through others, the scope and specification for the work must be agreed. Supporting evidence will be required before such funding is considered for approval.
2. The arrangements for procurement of any such project shall be considered on a case-by case basis and will take appropriate consideration of the project's risks and the need for public accountability and probity in its management. These arrangements shall be appropriately documented.
3. Once funding has been approved for a project to be carried out by a third party, the recipient is to use such funding solely for the purpose agreed. Failure to do so will require refund of the monies to the Council. The recipient shall demonstrate to the Council's satisfaction that funds have been appropriately disbursed, e.g. by allowing examination of the works carried out and of related documentation such as invoices, correspondence etc.
4. The requirements set out in the Standing Orders for precept-funded works and services will also apply in general for capital proceeds-funded work.
