Village Hall refurbishment - A whole new hall!

With the help of our partners on the Parish & County Councils, the Committee have scheduled a programme of works beginning this summer from 24th July.

The first stage of these improvements will include;

- A full electrical rewire (building in capacity for future facilities including stage lighting, a public address and sound system, security measures and Wi-Fi).
- Lowering of the ceiling in the main hall & installation of insulation to produce energy cost savings and improve acoustics.
- Fitting of new kitchen cupboards to provide extra storage & food preparation areas.

Unfortunately, the hall will be closed during the period of the works. Our weekly user groups will be making alternative arrangements or suspending activities for a four week period. We would like to thank our user groups and the community for their support, understanding and cooperation during this short period of disruption.
